COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Homeland Security met, pursuant to notice, in open markup session, a quorum being present, on Wednesday, June 19, 2019 in 310 of the Cannon House Office Building and considered the following measures:

H.R. 3256, (Mr. Richmond) To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to reauthorize and improve the Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards Program, and for other purposes. The “*Protecting and Securing Chemical Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of 2019*”.

The Committee took the following actions:

The Chair discharged the Subcommittee on Cybersecurity, Infrastructure Protection, and Innovation from further consideration of H.R. 3256.

H.R. 3256 was AGREED TO and ordered to be reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, as amendment by a roll call vote of 14 yeas to 12 nays (Roll No. 3).

The following amendment was offered:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Mr. Richmond. The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.
