To ensure Transportation Security Administration employees who contract COVID-19 are entitled to appropriate workers' compensation and other benefits, and for other purposes.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Coronavirus Workers'

1	SEC. 2. WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR TSA EMPLOYEES

3	(a) In General.—Any Transportation Security Ad-
4	ministration employee described in subsection (b) who is
5	diagnosed with COVID-19 during the period between
6	January 30, 2020, and January 30, 2022, shall, upon ap-
7	plication, presumptively be entitled to disability compensa-
8	tion, medical services, and any other benefit provided
9	under subchapter I of chapter 81 of title 5, United States
10	Code.
11	(b) TSA Employee.—A Transportation Security
12	Administration employee described in this subsection is
13	any of the following:
14	(1) A transportation security officer.
15	(2) A Federal air marshal.
