- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Enhancing Stakeholder
- 5 Support and Outreach for Preparedness Grants Act".

1 SEC. 2. DHS GRANT OUTREACH.

- 2 (a) Urban Area Security Initiative.—Section
