3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

1SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF GLOBAL ENTRY TO CERTAIN CHIL-2DREN.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security shall revise section 235.12 of title 8, Code of Federal 4 5 Regulations, to permit a child who is 10 or under who is not a member of Global Entry in accordance with such 6 7 section and who is traveling with such child's parent or 8 legal guardian who is a member of Global Entry in accord-9 ance with such section to accompany such parent or legal 10 guardian through a Global Entry lane upon arrival at an 11 international airport in the United States.

12 (b) APPOINTMENTS.—The Secretary of Homeland 13 Security shall take such actions as may be necessary to 14 permit a parent or legal guardian of up to four children 15 described in subsection (a) who is applying for member-16 ship in Global Entry on behalf of such children to schedule 17 a single appointment for an interview relating to such 18 membership for all such children.
