3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Darren Drake Act”.

1 (A) the Department of Homeland Security;

2 and

3 (B) rental companies, dealers, and other

4 relevant rental industry stakeholders.

5 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 (1) The terms “dealer”, and “rental company”

7 have the meanings given those terms in section

8 30102 of title 49, United States Code.

9 (2) The term “covered rental vehicle” means a

10 motor vehicle that—

11 (A) is rented without a driver for an initial

12 term of less than 4 months; and

13 (B) is part of a motor vehicle fleet of 35

14 or more motor vehicles that are used for rental

15 purposes by a rental company.
