In accordance with the attached Definitions and Instructions, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (“DHS” or “Department”) is hereby required to preserve and produce copies of the following materials in its possession, custody, or control, from **December 1, 2019 to the present**, regardless of classification or form, and whether draft or final:

1. All documents referring or relating to the decision to bar residents of New York State from DHS Trusted Traveler Programs;
2. All communications referring or relating to the decision to bar residents of New York State from DHS Trusted Traveler Programs including but not limited to communications between and among:
 - a) any DHS personnel;
 - b) DHS personnel and any White House personnel; and
 - c) any DHS personnel and personnel from any other federal agency;
3. All documents referring or relating to any limits on DHS’ access to information pertaining to driver’s licenses, vehicle registrations, and/or to any information contained in any database that stores information on driver’s licenses and/or vehicle registrations maintained by any state, territory, or district; and
4. All documents referring or relating to the identification of underlying facts by DHS or any other federal agency indicating that information provided or representations made to the Committee on Homeland Security, the U.S. Attorneys’ Office for the Southern District of New York, and/or to any federal court about the bases for restricting enrollment or re-enrollment of New York State residents in DHS Trusted Traveler Programs were, in any way, inaccurate or misleading.
