## A BILL

To terminate United States Secret Service protection for felons.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Denying Infinite Secu-  
5 rity and Government Resources Allocated toward Con-  
6 victed and Extremely Dishonorable Former Protectees  
7 Act” or the “DISGRACED Former Protectees Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DENYING CERTAIN FELONS SECRET SERVICE PRO-**  
2 **TECTION.**

3 Section 3056(a) of title 18, United States Code, is  
4 amended by striking “declined.” and inserting “declined.  
5 The protection authorized in paragraphs (1) through (8)  
6 shall terminate for any person upon sentencing following  
7 conviction for a Federal or State offense that is punishable  
8 for a term of imprisonment of at least one year.”.
